### *Jehovah Jireh: the LORD Will Provide*

This is a test. **What is my Isaac?**

Often in the tests of life, it is a matter of worship: Will I love the Blesser over the blessing?

When God allows me to go through tests that do not make sense, he is about to reveal himself to me in a new way. He is about to tell me his name.

Hebrews 11:19, "Abraham reasoned that God could raise the dead, and figuratively speaking, he did receive Isaac back from death." (NIV)

I have to believe that God will keep his promise in spite of the contradiction.

In the big tests of life, I am in a place where only God can supply the solution.

When I run away from a big test, I run away from a big manifestation of God.

### *Jehovah Rohi: the LORD My Shepherd*

**The Hebrew *Yahweh* or *Jehovah* is translated "LORD," and the Hebrew *Rohi* is translated "Shepherd."**

**If I am willing to be led by the Shepherd, he can provide for the needs of my life.**

**Will I follow him?**

John 10:11, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." (NIV)
